








# Setting the lead in research






The risk of Covid-19 disease was increased with the number of vaccine



### Covid-19 Vaccine Adverse Events

The report was prepared to determine whether sufficient pharmacovigilance data exists in WHO VigiAccess, CDC VAERS, EudraVigilance, and UK Yellow Card Scheme to establish a safety signal on Covid-19 vaccines.

# How many adverse events is too many?

Precedent for drug and vaccine recall

#### Summary:

The 1976 mass vaccination campaign was halted after a series of adverse event reports including 53. deaths. The polio vaccine was recalled in less than 1 year after 10 reported deaths. The Covid-19 vaccine, with over 28.000 associated reports of death on VAERS alone, has not been recalled.

There is sufficient evidence to indicate a recall of Covid-19 vaccines.

How many adverse events

is too many?

Given that Covid-19 vaccine development was rushed and that they are still in clinical trials, it is imperative to consider how pharmacovigilance data may be used to assess their safety, efficacy, and the case for their continued use.

Precedent from other pharmaceutical products suggests that the data are sufficient to indicate a recall of Covid-19 vaccines.

The 1976 swine flu

In February 1976, an investigation was launched into the mysterious death of an American Private who died during a basic training exercise. CDC tests revealed that Private David Levis had contacted a strain of Subsucementy 11 other soldiers tested positive for the vino while hundreds of others tested positive for antibodies. Alarming headlines appeared in merospeers across the country, and, the CDC blockort, citiling a "surge possibility" of a pandemic, recommended an unprecedented pland of mass vaccination of US citizens.

Though no further evidence emerged that the vinos was problematic, the CDC and then Private Certail Ford adopted a better safe than sorry approach, and began as mass vaccination campaign for the "When reports emerged of suspected adverse reactions, including heart attacks, Gallatio-Barré syndrome and 55 reported deaths, citizens began doubt the safety of the vaccine. Coupled with the fact the pandemic did not materialize as predicted, the government hatted the mass vaccination programme on December 16.

This one-day conference for UK doctors and other health professionals was a unique opportunity for attendees to network, collaborate, and explore solutions aimed at transforming prevailing challenges into opportunities. The overarching goal was to empower excellent health for all.

#### UK Doctors' Declaration

We, the undersigned UK doctors, publicly declare our grave concern about the violation of medical eth-ics that has become apparent in both clinical practice and scientific research, with the potential to result in serious harm to patients.

We stand for honouring our commitment to always obtain fully informed consent prior to undertaking any medical intervention, as required by the NHS Constitution, the UK's General Medical Council (NMC) and the law.

We stand for medical practice that respects each patient's right to reach autonomous and free decisions about their treatment and care, instead of following generic protocols and guidelines without thorough about their treatment and care, instead of following generic protocols and guidelines without thorough about their treatment applicability to an individual and their preferences.

We must be at liberty to gasher and freely discuss evidence and information, according to our professional skills in appraising the scientific literature, without fear of being reprimanded for debating a prevailing narrative.

We must be at liberty to ask critical questions and discuss safety concerns with patients.

We stand for the sanctity of the patient-doctor relationship, where clinical conduct is bound by the detailed principles of Good Medical Practice and doctors' professional judgement, rather than protocols designed by governing bodies with vested political and economic interests.

We stand for transparency, honesty and integrity of all those who apply and inform medical practice, including researchers, advisory and regulatory bodies.

We are aware of and concerned about the elser potential for compromised integrity within the advisory was are guitancy bodies, which we rely on for guidance and support to protect our patients from harm. We are aware and concerned that the process of making an investigational medicinal product available for immediate mass administration, has been highly irregular and inconsistent with established scientific practice.

With this declaration we are fulfilling our date and surjourned and investigational medicinal product available practice.

With this declaration we are fulfilling our duty, as outlined by the GMC, to take action when we see that patient safety is being compromised, as our concerns relate to potential serious harm to patients.



# BIRD AND WORLD IVERMECTIN DAY




#### **BiRD**




